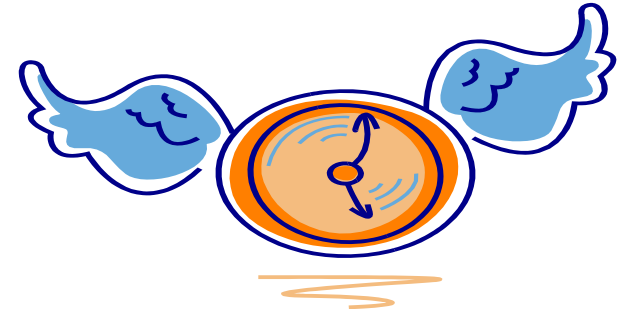


TIME
