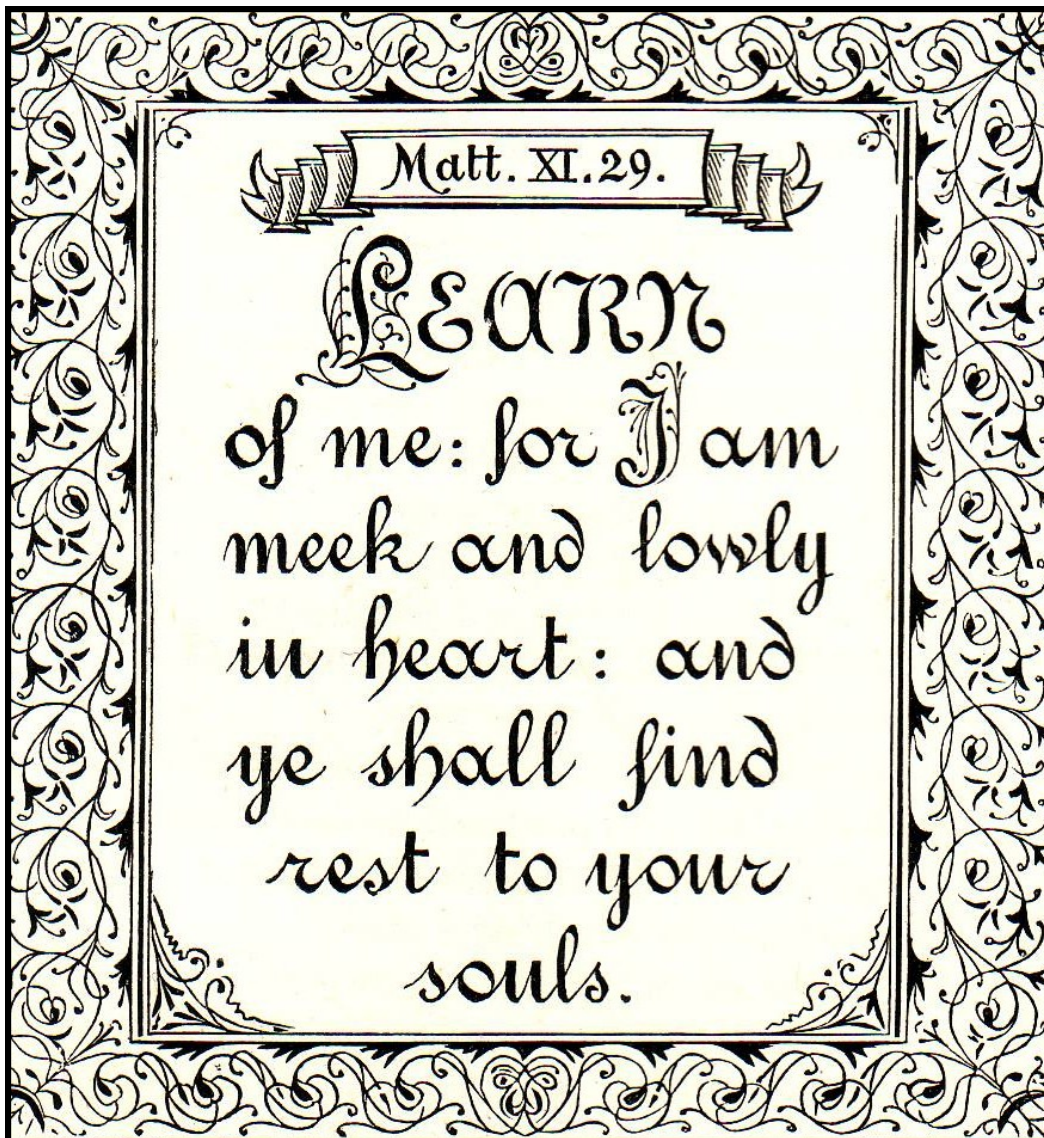


9. THE GREAT TEACHER ... PART II
