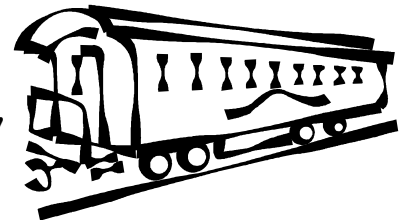


FAMOUS GIRLS...
