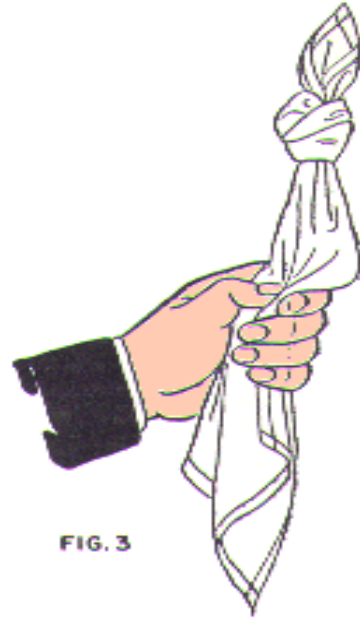


# 'Tying a knot in your handkerchief'
