6. The flag speaks of union, a union of Christian nations.
7. When the Israelites spoke of the Lord as their 'banner', they meant that the Lord was their k____ and leader.
8. It is the duty of a s____, or a citizen to follow the flag and **a Christian must follow Christ.**
9. A soldier must be l____ to the flag, and **a Christian should be loyal to Christ.**
