'Who am I, that I should go unto Pharaoh?'

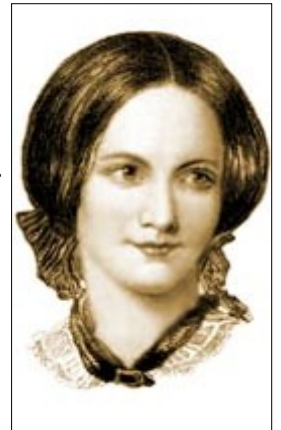
Exodus 3 v 11

1. We are thinking about 'fear'. There is a g\_\_\_ kind of fear, and a b\_\_\_ kind of fear.
2. Fear itself is not sinful, because...
  - if we are afraid to do wr\_\_\_, that is good.
  - if we see some d\_\_\_\_\_ ahead, the fear of it makes us avoid it, so that is good.
3. If we fear that our souls will be l\_\_\_, and we ask Our Lord Jesus Christ to save us, that also is a g\_\_\_ kind of fear.
4. If we are t\_\_\_\_\_ to do wrong, and we fear that our wrong-doing will hurt someone else, or h\_\_\_ us, or o\_\_\_\_\_ God, then that too is a good kind of fear.
5. At first, Moses was afraid to do what God asked him to do - to go to Ph\_\_\_\_\_ and ask for the Israelite slaves to be set f\_\_\_\_\_.
6. We can understand M\_\_\_\_\_ fear, but **we should never be afraid of doing what God commands.**
