

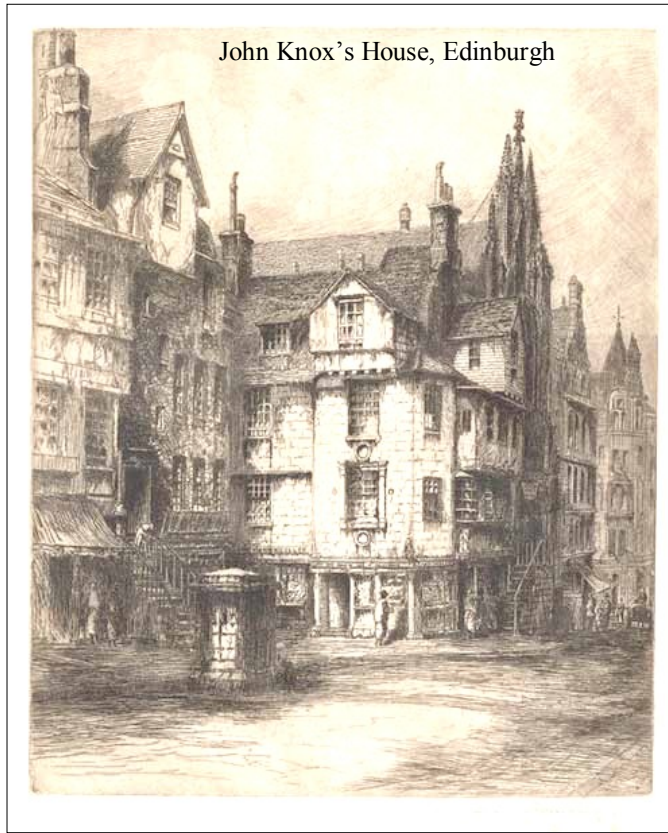
1. In the city of Edinburgh, there are many very tall houses. Some are divided up into flats on different floors.
