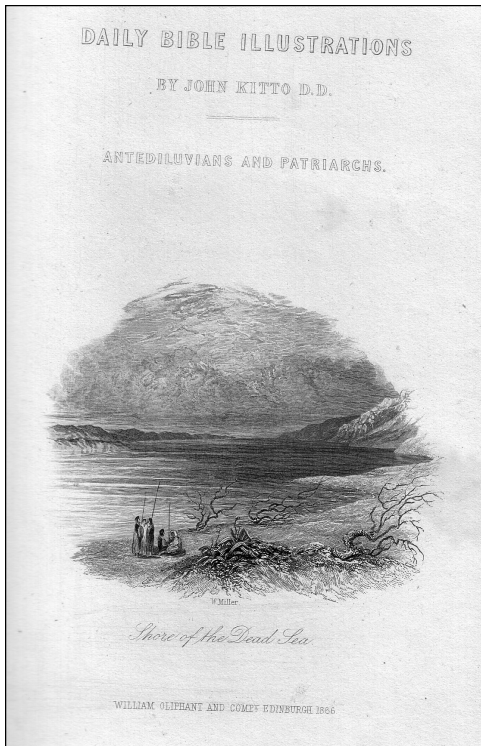


# JOHN KITTO - PART I
