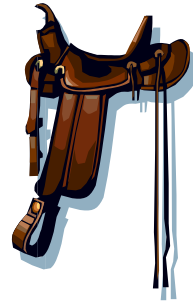


Famous Boys..JOHN KITTO (part 2)
