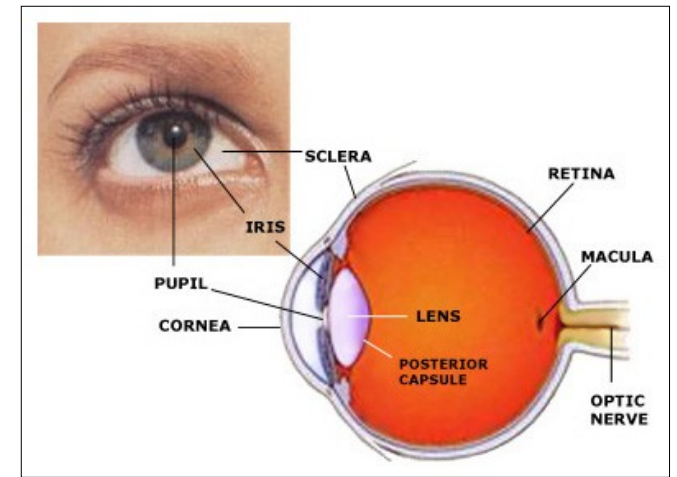


The Apple of the Eye

'..Keep me as the apple of the eye..'

Psalm 17 v 8



1. The 'apple of the eye' is the little black spot, the 'p____', in the centre of the coloured part of the eye (the 'iris').
2. Of all the parts of the e__ that we can see, it is the most important, because it is the part through which l____ enters.

6. The apple of the eye is also very sensitive. Our Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ, is very sen_____ towards His People. What hurts them, h____ Him. (See Matt 25 :40& 45)

3. When the psalmist asks God to keep him as 'the apple of the eye' he is really asking to be kept safe.

5. Again, when the psalmist asks to be kept as 'the apple of the eye', he is reminding himself that God's P_____ are very precious to Him, just as sight is pr_____. (Story of a father who took his son up a very high hill).
