



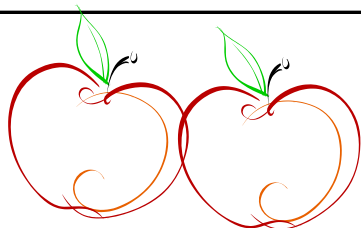
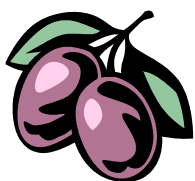
A Handful of Corn Harvest
