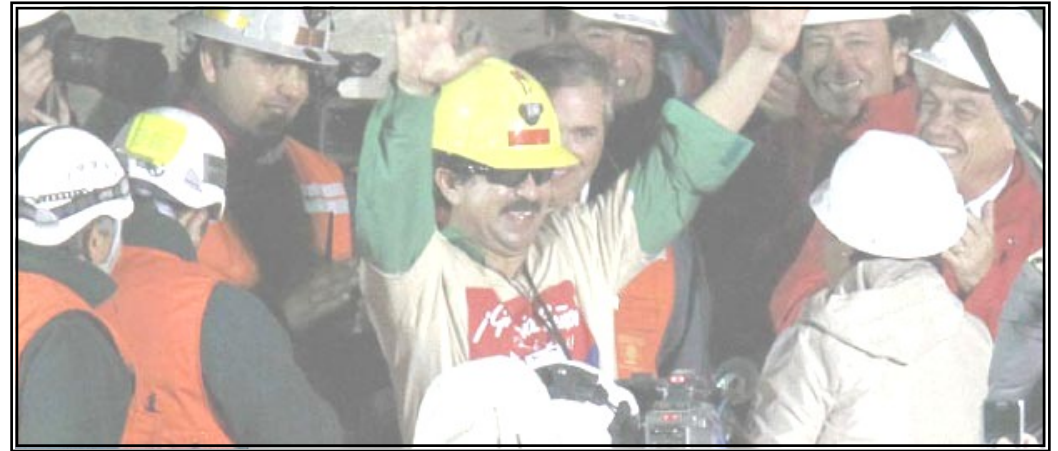


The Men in the Mine

11. All the men rescued, wore T shirts on which were written the words of Psalm ___ v ___.

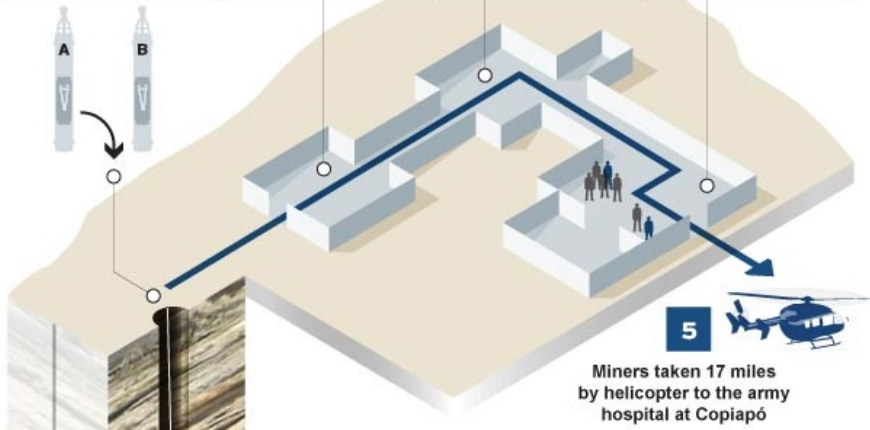

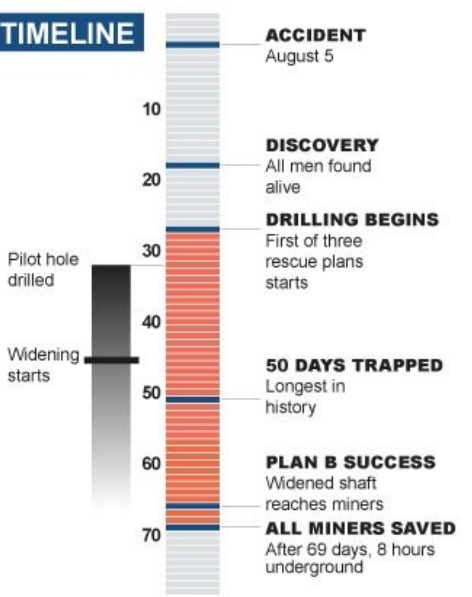

THE RESCUE

- 1 RESCUE**
The 33 miners lifted to surface in one of two rescue capsules
- 2 ASSESSMENT**
Each miner given a 10 minute preliminary assessment
- 3 FIELD HOSPITAL**
Miners kept under observation for four hours
- 4 FAMILY ROOM**
In the family meeting room, each miner saw three chosen relatives or friends
