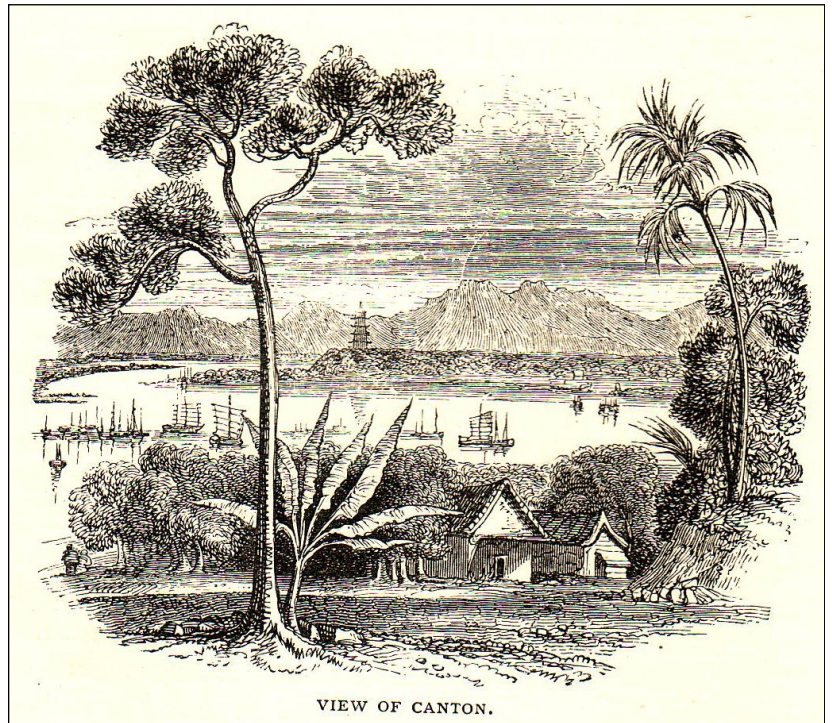


TREASURES ON THE DEEP
