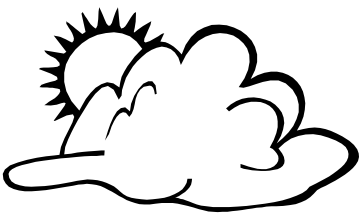
Cirrus -very h___ clouds
