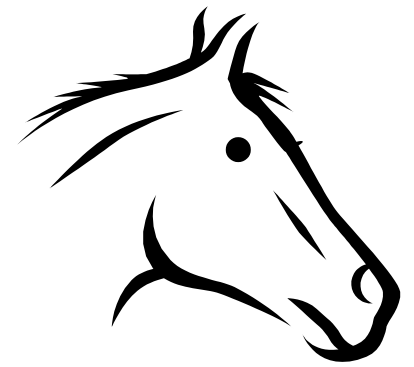

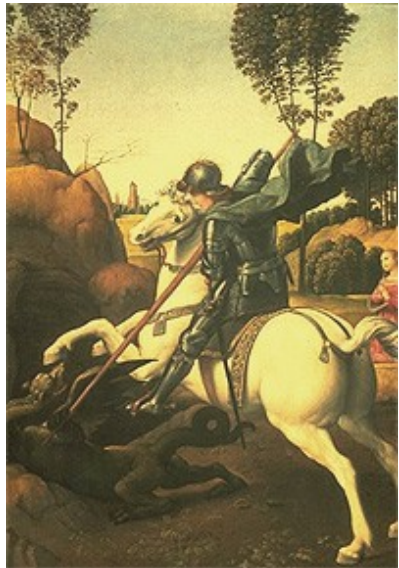

2. St George, the patron saint of

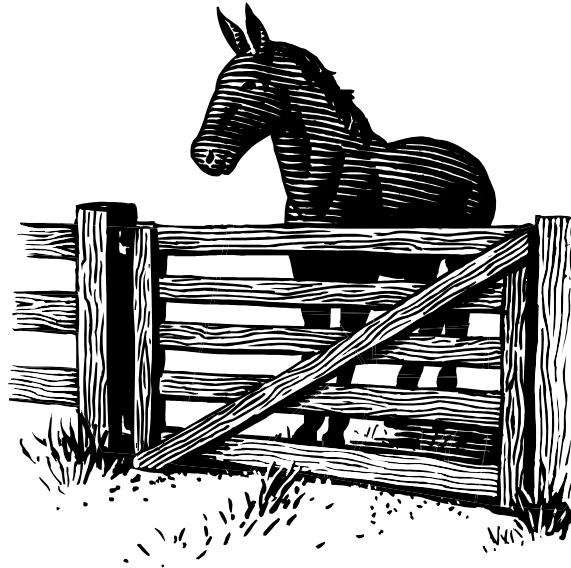
E\_\_\_\_\_, is always pictured as riding a horse.
