1. The mule is a cross between a h_____ and a d_____. God forbade the Jews to breed mules, to stop the world being filled with monsters.

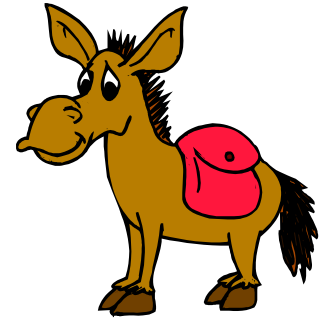
Anah the Horite is said to have been the first man to breed mules.
